What is on the counter at the small store? The man's \$20 bill.

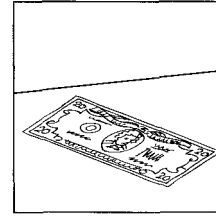
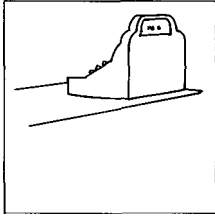
