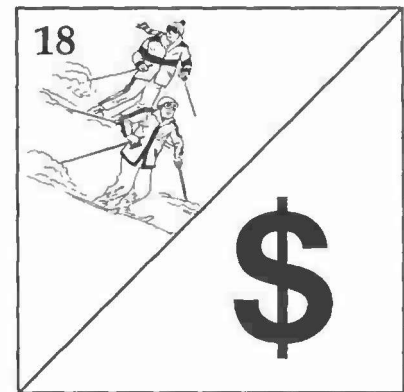
Finally, they burn their \$20 bills.
